If your spouse is attending, this should be paid at the Registration desk on Sun 22nd and or Mon 23rd May.

Tivua Island: Where warm waters, acres of coral gardens, and soft white beaches await. This day cruise afloat a magnificent tall ship, "Spirit of the Pacific", combines sailing through crystal-clear seas to a Fijian island with buffet lunch spreads and plenty of activities too—just don't forget your sunscreen.


