Dr. M.I.M. Jazeel is a senior lecturer Gr. I in the Department of Islamic Studies of Faculty of Islamic Studies and Arabic Language at South Eastern University of Sri Lanka. He holds a Bachelor of Arts (Hons) Second Upper (1997) and Master of Arts (2003) from University of Peradeniya. He obtained his doctorate degree (Ph.D.) in leadership studies from the National University of Malaysia (UKM) in 2010. In addition, he followed professional courses in order to sharpen his

knowledge of the field and for the advancement in his career. He has a considerable teaching and research experience spanning nearly twenty years. He has been teaching courses on Islamic Thought and Civilization. He also supervise students undertaking the postgraduate studies.

Jazeel researches in the area falls predominantly within the role of Islam and Muslim's contribution in the national development.
