

Dr. Ranjith Pallegama is a senior lecturer in physiology attached to the Faculty of Dental Sciences, University of Peradeniya. He graduated from the Faculty of Dental Sciences with honors in 1997 and received the PhD from Tokyo Medical and Dental University in 2005. Presently he is the Director of the Staff Development Center of the University of Peradeniya.
