I joined the Academic staff of the Department of Veterinary Clinical Sciences (DVCS), Faculty of Veterinary Medicine & Animal Science (FVMAS) as a Temporary Assistant Lecturer in October 1979 after obtaining a BVSc (2nd Class Honours) degree from University of Peradeniya and was made permanent in 1982. I obtained my PhD in

1988 from University of Cambridge UK, and was serving in the capacity of the Senior Lecturer in Grade II and I in Veterinary Surgery. I have held various administrative positions in the FVMAS, including Head of the Department at present and also from 1998-2005, Chairperson Faculty Higher Degrees Committee for 10 years (2003-2014), Coordinator of the Veterinary Post graduate Education Unit (3 years), Deputy Proctor, Senior Student Counselor, Acting Dean at several occasions, Member of Faculty planning Committee, Quality Assurance committee etc..

I served as a person in-charge of the of an activity (Establishing a conducive learning environment) which included establishing a new Veterinary Teaching Hospital and other Common amnesties (Common room, toilets, canteen, library, IT centre etc) under IRQUE Project.
