Best Practices of IQAU (3 best)

- * Department Level: defined roles for dept. QA coordinators encompassing course delivery planning, assessment (moderation/model solutions), peer reviewing, record keeping, dept. level monitoring, coordinating with Faculty QA Cell
- * Faculty Level: Physically allocated space for QA Cell with Secretarial assistance and resources (Engineering Fac), Close coordination with dept. QA coordinators
- * University Level: Review of report submitted by Dir/IQAU at the Senate for self correction and planning



Constraints faced by IQAU (3 most pressing)

- * Not having properly functioning QA activities for Administration and Infrastructure Facilities within the Institute level QA implementation Framework (being addressed)
- * Not having physical spaces and resources for QA cells in Faculties other than Engineering (will be addressed)
- * Lack of awareness of some staff members on the NET BENEFITS that a properly implemented QA framework would bring about in a higher learning environment (shall be addressed)
