- * Adoption of university wide QA procedures developed at CETMe to maintain the quality standards of all learning material, ie print, online, OER etc. across faculties.
- * Monitoring of progress of faculty QA cells and providing support in quality assurance procedures.
- * Assisting in developing the Strategic Management Plan of the 2016 2020 and Monitoring its implementation.



Constraints faced by IQAU (3 most pressing)

- * Lack of full time staff involved in QA activities within the university prevents the implementation of QA policies and practices to the full potential within the expected time period.
- * Commitment among staff in maintaining QA standards is varied.
- * Limited student interest in providing constructive feedback on courses and programmes of study.
